Whilst our 'Morris Traveller' by coach on 12th May is full you maybe interested in the itinerary in case you wanted to pop along and watch the Morris perform and enjoy a Real Ale in one of the pubs? We will be at each pub about an hour and the times are only approximate, Hanover Harwich - 11.45am, Cross Inn Great Bromley – 1.15pm, Plough Inn Great Bentley 2.15pm, Black Boy Weeley – 3.15pm & Blacksmiths Arms Little Clacton – 4.15pm.

There are spare seats (£20 each) available for our Historic pub walk-about in Greenwich on Saturday 4th August. If you are interested please get back to me. We will spend about 45 minutes in each pub with a short 5 to 10 minutes historical talk by Robert Molyneux. There will be a 1 ½ hour break for lunch &/or an optional visit around the Cutty Sark. The cost of Cutty Sark is £13.50 and takes about 60 minutes. During the walk Robert will also be giving information on other places of interest we pass. Robert has previously done several guided tours of the area.

Off the beaten track in a remote part of North East Essex we went down a very muddy unmade up dirt track and very nearly got the mini buses stuck on our way to Delvin End Cidery. Then we went to the White Hart Halstead (a 15th century coaching inn) brew pub and gin distillery. On offer in the pub was Metropolis from Colchester Brewery and 4 of their own beers Colne Valley Stout, Golden Hart, Halstead Bitter and Market Hill Mild. They were all in great condition and our party was equally split between the Golden Hart and the Stout. They were so good we have placed an advanced order for them to be included at our beer festivals.
