This picture was taken inside the old treadmill crane in Harwich during our historic tour. It was erected in 1667 in the Navel Dockyard. This is the only surviving original double tread mill crane in the world, it is a Scheduled National Monument & a grade 11* listed building, Even though the weather could have been better I thought this went very well. I was particularly pleased we were the first party to get inside the house of Christopher Jones Master of the Mayflower. Tendring District Council had just handed Andy (our tour guide) the keys to the house and he is now the Curator. The arrangement is until the end of 2020 - the conclusion of the Mayflower Celebrations the hope is that the house can remain with the Harwich Society but that will need to be financed.
