Results from this years Harwich Sausage Festival. The Innovation Class winner the Alma Inn with their cheese and onion sausage, second place went to Becky's Butchers with a venison and cranberry sausage.

The Butchers Class winner was **Becky's Butchers** with their legendary **pork and leek** recipe. Second place went to Danny Spence of D. Spence Family Butchers with his "Bentley Banger" and Page Butchers of Ramsey came in third with their pork and red onion recipe. Becky is our Overall Champion for 2019 with her pork and leek sausage and will be put forward for the national Champion of Champions competition in 2020. The 2019 throwing competition was won by current sausage throwing champion Todd Rothwell chucking for the Alma Inn with his first throw of 171 feet. Second was George Webb throwing for Page Butchers of Ramsey with a throw of 152 feet. This means that there is a new Harwich sausage throwing record of 171 feet, with Todd breaking the previous record of 157 feet he set in 2017.
