Those of you that take note of the membership numbers will notice we are still shrinking slightly. Which given the time we have been through is not a surprise. However with two branch Beer Festivals taking place soon we hope that trend can be reversed. We do hope you can find the time to visit and enjoy our festivals.

If you live in the Clacton area there are two spare seats on the minibus for the Harwich Redoubt Beer Festival trip on **Saturday 30th July**. This is probably the most atmospheric venue you are likely to attend, The only event I attended that matched this was the one held in Colchester Castle when it was stripped back to the bones.

On **Saturday 20th August** we are once again doing our Clacton pub walk-about which helps promote our Beer Festival the week after. If you are working at the festival you will be provided with a festival T-shirt for the walk. We will start at the Ship Great Clacton at about 11 am and end up in the town pubs stopping at the Railway club on route, which has been a highlight in previous years. No transport will be provided for this trip. However there are a number of buses that stop near by. If you do take part please let me know and we will not leave the Ship until all are in attendance.

Another great Beer Festival is the famous Chappel festival which runs from 6th to the 10th September. As a branch we will travel by train (which in itself enhances the experience) on **Wednesday 7th September**.
