As this will be the first year we will celebrate 'Apple Day' here is some information about it. The first 'Apple Day' was held on 21st October 1990 in Covent Garden, London. It is an annual celebration of apples and orchards. It is a way of celebrating and demonstrating that variety and richness matter to a locality. Also traditional orchards should be conserved for their contribution to local distinctiveness, including the rich diversity of wild life they support. Obviously it gives us an opportunity to promote cider & perry and some of the pubs in our area that stock them. CAMRA has set October aside as Cider & Perry Month, in the same way as May is set aside as Mild Month.
