This was one of the 6 Real Ale pubs in Walton we visited and is the only pub in Tendring that has a listing on CAMRA's Pub Heritage website. Built c.1828 as the Marine Hotel the lounge bar was a former shop and the public bar on the right has been created within the old coaching arch. A part glazed partition with 'Lounge Bar' in coloured glass separates the two rooms. The high-ceilinged, part-panelled lounge bar is very much the star here with most of its late 1930 fittings intact.
