Our next Social Trip is the Chappel Beer Festival by train on Wednesday 6th September. There is no need to pre-book with me, however if you do so I will let the others travelling from your area know as you may wish to travel together. If groups of 3 to 9 travel together you get a 1/3 off your railway ticket price. Some of us will be getting the 12.05 train from Clacton.

In support of CAMRA's Cider & Perry Promotion Month we will hold our Pam Rivers Apple Day pub run-about on Saturday 21st October. Which is the actual date of Common Ground's National Apple Day. The first 'Apple Day' was held on 21st October 1990 in Covent Garden, London. It is an annual celebration of apples and orchards. It is a way of celebrating and demonstrating that variety and richness matter to a locality. Also traditional orchards should be conserved for their contribution to local distinctiveness, including the rich diversity of wild life they support, like the rare noble chafer beetle & lesser-spotted woodpecker. Obviously it gives us an opportunity to promote some of the pubs in our area that stock Real Cider & Perry.

We will visit at least 4 pubs that stock real cider and have a light buffet in one of them. The cost will be £15 a head which will include transport, buffet and a donation in memory of Pam to St Helena Hospice. Depending on your location transport maybe available so if you are interested please reply to the email address above & let me have your home location.
