After that the next social will be a visit to the 'wacky' seventh Harwich Sausage Festival on Saturday 4th November. There is a sausage throwing competition and public sausage taste-off in the participating pubs. Whilst all the mini bus seats for this are also taken there is good public transport to Harwich during the day so you could still join us there.

The throwing event takes place from about 11.30am beside Saint Nicholas Church and the Hanover Inn in Harwich. The contest takes about 30 minutes then people amble between the 3 nearby participating pubs (Alma, Hanover & New Bell) to taste the competing sausages (not the thrown ones!) and cast their vote for the tastiest 'Sausage of the Festival'.
