Tendring CAMRA RambAle route 7 Maybush, Great Oakley to Kirby-le-Soken

Start: Great Oakley

Finish: Kirby-le-Soken

Total Distance: 7.5 miles

Maybush, Great Oakley to Ship, Kirby-le-Soken

Distance : 7.2 miles

Turn left out of the Maybush along Farm Road and take the track to the right, a public footpath, as the houses end, opposite Elberns. Alternatively Follow Farm Road to the end and turn right into Pesthouse Lane. When you reach Beaumont Road, cross over to the pavement and turn left. The pavement ends as you reach Red Barn Lane, so take care as you walk on the right past the next few cottages. Take the footpath to the right after Rose Cottage, just before the speed limit increases to the national limit. Follow the footpath across a field. It will join a track which leads to Harwich Road. Cross the road carefully to the footpath directly opposite. This bends to the right around the back of Horseshoes (a former pub, now a private residence). Follow this track for a short distance until it reaches a crossroad of footpaths, and turn left down the hill. This footpath leads to Quay Lane (Beaumont) which you can cross to pick up the footpath on the sea wall. When this path reaches Landermere Quay you will need to turn left on the track and pass Kingshead (another former pub, now a private residence), then opposite Campbells Cottage turn left to follow the footpath along the sea wall again. After about 3 more miles there will be a public footpath on your right which leads into Kirby-le-Soken; the Ship will be a short distance to your left when you reach the main road (if you miss this and reach Quay Lane (Kirby-le-Soken), take Quay Lane into Kirby-le-Soken and the Ship is to the right when you meet the main road).

Ship, Kirby-le-Soken to Red Lion, Kirby-le-Soken

Distance: 0.3 miles

Turn right out of the Ship and keep going until you reach the Red Lion (on your right, opposite the church)
