It runs from 6pm to 11pm Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> & 11am to 11pm Thursday to Saturday. There is music on Thursday evening, Saturday afternoon & Saturday evening.

This year we are making a few changes which we hope you will notice.

We will have an increased selection of ciders and International beers (including an alcohol free option!).

We have a 'Bar take-over' Wednesday from 6 to 9pm. Normally this means beers are sourced from one brewery, however the bar will be staffed by members of the White Hart Beer Club. If you know of a beer club or pub that would like to try this next year please ask them to get in contact.

We will also have a KeyKeg bar - despite the name 'keg' the ale is 'real', with no gas coming into contact with the beer. If you know of a pub or club that struggles to sell 'real ale' because of low turnover maybe this is the answer.
